## **Local young professionals raise over £2,000 for Mind West Cumbria**

Employees from Sellafield Ltd, Morgan Sindall Infrastructure and Arup recently held a charity fundraiser which raised £2,295.45 for Mind West Cumbria, a local branch of the mental health charity. From their office base in Workington, Mind offer a variety of services to support the local residents in Allerdale and Copeland suffering from mental health issues.

The event was organised by a group of young professionals who all work on the Infrastructure Strategic Alliance (ISA) a £1.1 billion contract which is a joint venture between Morgan Sindall Infrastructure and Arup working in partnership with Sellafield Ltd providing essential infrastructure assets to the Sellafield site.
